Light can momentarily be a game-changer.

Darkness & light matter over the long haul
Not just a game-changer, an E life-changer.
Light makes all the difference.
Then Jesus told them, "You are going to have the light just a
little while longer. Walk while you have the light, before
darkness overtakes you.
Whoever walks in the dark does not know where they are going.
Believe in the light while you have the light, so that you may
become children of light." John 12:35-36
Jesus was talking about His physical presence in the world. But not <u>only</u> about that. He was talking to <u>us</u> also. He implies that the world seems to have seasons of light and darkness. Not as predictable as the sunrise and sunset.
Also, some people live as "C of light". We can follow them and they will lead us closer to God. But many live as children of darkness. It matters who we follow. "Clear it with the Spirit."

As he neared Damascus on his journey, suddenly a light from
heaven flashed around him. He fell to the ground and heard
a voice say to him, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute Me?"
"Who are You, Lord?" Saul asked.
"I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting," He replied. "Now get up and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do."
The men traveling with Saul stood there speechless; they heard
the sound but did not see anyone. Saul got up from the
ground, but when he opened his eyes he could see nothing.
So they led him by the hand into Damascus. For three days
he was blind, and did not eat or drink anything

Then Ananias went to the house and entered it. Placing his hands on Saul, he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord—Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you were coming here—has sent me so that you may see again and be filled with the Holy Spirit." Immediately, something like scales fell from Saul's eyes, and he could see again. He got up and was baptized, and after taking some food, he regained his strength.

Acts 9:1-19
